CHILDREN'S SUNDAY SCHOOL SUPERINTENDANT AND TEACHERS NEEDED:

The Board of Christian Education (BCE) is looking for a Sunday School Superintendant and Teachers for 2010-2011. If you love children, teaching, and spreading the Word of God, this is a wonderful opportunity for you.
