Everyone is invited to become a part of Trinity's YarnWork Ministry. Please join us and recruit your friends and neighbors! We *work at home* on our projects and then get together quarterly to make future plans. You can knit, crochet, or weave any of the items below. We are always grateful for donated yarn, too.

There are *no deadlines* and *no assignments* for projects. You chose what you want to work on bring the items to church when you are finished. Give them to Judy Russell, Kay Watts, or put them in the YarnWork Ministry Box in the LWML closet.

We have patterns for your use, or you can use your own favorites. There are hundreds of free patterns on the internet if you search for "free crochet patterns," or "free knitting patterns." Most of the charities prefer acrylic items, since they are easily washable.

We knit, weave, or crochet such items as:

- 12 inch squares (which will be assembled by charities into afghans)
- scarves (about 6 by 60 inches)
- any size hats
- prayer/friendship shawls (about 15 by 60 inches)
- lapghans (small afghans about 35 by 42)
- baby blankets (about 35 by 42 inches)
- regular afghans (about 45 by 60inches)
- crosses for bookmarks (for baptismal gifts)

At our quarterly meetings, we discuss national or local charities for which to fill a boxes for mailing.

We also make items for Trinity members. We hope that the Pastor, the Vicar, and the Congregational Life Director will identify members who would enjoy a small gift. We keep a supply of items available for the them to use as greetings or get-well gifts from the congregation.
