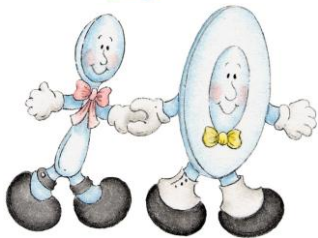
Friday, February 10 – Book Swap
